## Completion of Sale of 17173 Business to Changyou.com

On December 15, 2011, the registrant ("Sohu") completed its previously announced sale of the business of 17173.com, a leading game information portal in China (the "17173 Business"), to Changyou.com Limited, an indirect majority-owned subsidiary of the registrant ("Changyou").

The sale was made pursuant to a Master Transaction Agreement (the "<u>Transaction Agreement</u>"), dated as of November 29, 2011, between, on the one hand, Sohu and certain of its subsidiaries and variable interest entities as Sellers, and, on the other hand, Changyou and certain of its subsidiaries and variable interest entities as Buyers. A brief description of the terms and conditions of the Transaction Agreement may be found in the registrant's Current Report on Form 8-K filed with the SEC on December 1, 2011, which description is qualified in its entirety by reference to the full text of the Transaction Agreement filed as Exhibit 10.1 thereto.
